As the recently appointed AHP Director for Residencies, I am pleased to announce that the African Humanities Program has revised one of the popular program add-ons that was offered to the recipients of an AHP fellowship award whereby a PhD award winner could spend two-three months conducting his/ her research at a residential centre based in another of the countries participating in the African Humanities Program.

In terms of the revisions to the popular residency offering, all AHP fellows, past and present, holding a PhD can now apply to spend a period of two – three months to conduct research under the guidance of a dedicated mentor based at one of the participating Residency Centres located in a country other than their own.
